Welcome to The HERstory Project! To ensure a safe, inclusive, and respectful environment for all participants, we have established this Code of Conduct. By engaging with our platform, you agree to adhere to the following guidelines:

\*'Community' is used throughout this Code of Conduct to denote any person who engages with the site and wider Project as a writer, editor or other team member, or any consumer of Project content. \*

## 1. Respect and Inclusivity

- 1.1. Respect Others: Treat all community members with respect and kindness. Be considerate of diverse backgrounds, perspectives, and experiences.
- 1.2. Inclusivity: Embrace diversity and foster an inclusive environment. Avoid language, behaviour, or content that may exclude or marginalize individuals.

## 2. Positive and Supportive Communication

- 2.2. No Harassment: Harassment of any form, including but not limited to intimidation, discrimination, or unwelcome advances, will not be tolerated.

- 3.2. Consent: Obtain permission before sharing or using content created by others within the community.

## 4. Responsible Content
